

Report of the seminar on “Vectors and Vector borne diseases”

A seminar on Vectors and Vector borne diseases was held at Chandrapur College on 23rd August 2017. The seminar aimed at creating awareness among the students and staff of the College on prevention of vector borne diseases like Dengue, Malaria, Chikunguniya was being organized by two NSS Units of Chandrapur College.

DR Kartick Ch. Samanta, Principal of the college inaugurated the seminar. DR. Amal Krishna Mondal, Block Medical Officer of Health, Katwa-I was present as chief guest.

In his speech DR. Mondal said that people are most vulnerable to vector borne disease at the time of flood. He elaborates that skin diseases, Diarrhea, Persistent cough and High fever are the symptoms of vector borne diseases.

He appealed to the students and staff to immediately consult doctors if they come across like such symptoms to prevent vector borne diseases like Dengue, Japanese Encephalitis, Swine Flu etc. He also suggested that people should give up habit of sleeping outdoors, inhabitants should clean water containers weekly, water storage tanks should be covered with lids. People should use personal protective measures to prevent diseases spread by mosquitoes.
