- a. What is a Prologue? Comment on the originality of Sudraka's Prologue in *Mrichchhakatika*.
- b. Comment on the significance of the Court Scene (Act IX) in Mrichchhakatika.
- c. Comment critically on the dramatic function of Vasantasena's ornaments in *Mrichchakatika*.
- d. Write a short note on the role of Vidusaka in Mrichchhakatika.
- e. Kalidasa's Abhijnana Shakuntalam explores self-sacrificing love. Discuss.
- f. Discuss Father Kanva's counsels to Shakuntala for leading a happy marital life, as she leaves the hermitage to meet her husband in the court.
- g. Dushyanta's painting expresses his pangs of sorrow when separated from Shakuntala, in Kalidasa's *Abhijnana Shakuntalam*. Discuss.
- h. Comment on Dushyanta's recognition of son Sarvadamana and reunion with Shakuntala?
- 2. Answer *any three* of the following questions: 10x3=30
- a. "The view of life presented in 'The Book of the Assembly Hall' of *The Mahabharata* is that of a magical reality, rather than a rigid theological vision of life as unreality." Substantiate your answer.
- b. Analyse the chief rasas in relation to Kalidasa's portrayal of themes and characters in *Abhijnana Shakuntalam*.
- c. Comment on Kalidasa's presentation of two contrasted worlds, the pleasure garden and the penance grove, side by side in *Abhijnana Shakuntalam*?
- d. Write a critical note on the character of Vasantasena as presented in the play *Mrichchhakatika*.
- e. Critically consider Bana's Kadambari as a fine specimen of katha.
